



He qualified in that year as a graded arbitrator with the Institute of Arbitrators and Mediators Australia

He was Editor of Laws of Australia: Transport from 1990 to 2023 and has presented papers at international congresses in Taipei, Beijing, Shanghai, Seoul, Montreal, Athens and Bristol.
